"Inscriptions;"
Engraved in Stone

Walking among the ruins of Rome one is aware of how many inscriptions there are engraved in stone. On the Arch of Constantine, built in 315 AD, a hundred yards from the famous coliseum, there are many engravings in stone relating the emperor's conquests. The main engraving (in Latin) begins with the famous abbreviation: S. P. Q. R. which stood for "SENATUS POPULUSQUE ROMANUS" ("the Senate and the people of Rome").

God used extensive engravings in the temple and on priest's garments. The priests breastplate was adorned with 12 precious stones upon which was engraved the names of the 12 tribes. On their turban Moses was instructed to "make a plate of pure gold and shall engrave on it, like engravings of a seal, "Holy to the Lord. (Ex. 27: 21,36).

One would be correct to take from all this that engravings were important in both political and religious fields. They made important statements! So it is not strange that with Christ's new covenant we are told that "I will put My laws into their minds, and I will write them on their hearts" (He. 8:10). If you have been cleansed from your sins, as a holy priesthood (1 Pe. 2:9) now upon your heart is engraved, "Holy to the Lord." Wear these words proudly, and honor them in your daily life.
