## "Inscriptions;" The Forgotten Holiday

Is it just me, or does it seem that Christmas decorations have been going up very early this year? In most stores, city streets, and on the internet, Christmas stuff is already filling the shelves, streets and websites. What happened to Thanksgiving? Has it become the forgotten holiday?

Unlike many of our Holidays, Thanksgiving actually has biblical support. There were sacrifices of thanksgiving in the Old Law (Lev. 22:29). Psalm 16 is a great hymn of Thanksgiving by David in which he proclaims "Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is good" (vs. 34). The pilgrims held the first Thanksgiving to thank God for blessing them with a good harvest, which would see them through the harsh winter.

Fourteen times in the New Testament we are encouraged to be thankful. We are taught to be thankful; in our words (Ep. 5:4), in our prayers (Col. 4:2,6), for one another (1 Th. 3:9), for our food (Mt. 15:36), for our faith (Ro. 1:8, Co. 2:7), for our salvation ( Ro. 6:17), for creation (1 Tm. 4:4), and for our God (Re. 7:12). This coming week put your Christmas shopping aside for a day or two, gather your family around the dinner table, and later, around the Lord's Table, pause life for a few moments, look around, look up, and be thankful!
